- ☺ If you happen to get behind on your Memory Challenge assignments, the work can be made up anytime before the Award in June. Many children make up or complete previous years.
- ☺ If you have trouble learning the assignments, **ask for help** from your parents, Bible class teachers, or Jon and Rebecca Bos. They will be happy to help you.

NOTE: The intention of this memory item is for you to think, in depth, upon the leadership of the church and the duties and responsibilities of a deacon and to discuss religious topics with someone other than a family member. We hope that this memory item will encourage and assist you to begin or continue formulating your conclusions based upon scripture.

GUIDELINES/HINTS: There is more than one Bible passage dealing with deacons. Be prepared to look up passages and discuss them. The interview with a deacon should include more than when this man became a deacon and how long he has been a deacon and should take more than 15 minutes.

## APRIL

II Peter 3:10-11

10. But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up.
